Mr. Johnson of South Dakota introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To amend the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act to include ranching educational activities in the Farm to School Program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

This Act may be cited as the 'Farm and Ranch to School Act of 2019'.

SEC. 2. FARM AND RANCH TO SCHOOL PROGRAM.

Section 18(g) of the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act ([42 U.S.C. 1769\(g\)](#)) is amended-

(1) in the heading, by inserting 'and Ranch' after 'Farm';

(2) in paragraph (3)(A)-

(A) by redesignating clauses (vi) and (vii) as clauses (vii) and (viii); and

(B) by inserting after clause (v) the following:

'(vi) education activities in curriculum planning that encourage the participation of school children in ranching, livestock production, and meat processing educational activities;'

(3) in paragraph (5)-

(A) in subparagraph (A), by inserting 'and meats' after 'products';

(B) by redesignating subparagraphs (D) through (G) as subparagraphs (E) through (H), respectively; and

(C) by inserting after subparagraph (C) the following:

'(D) incorporate education activities in curriculum planning that encourage the participation of school children in ranching, livestock production, and meat processing educational activities;'; and

(4) in paragraph (8), by adding at the end the following:

'(C) Reservation. The Secretary shall reserve 50 percent of the amounts made available under subparagraph (A) and paragraph (9) to carry out the activities described in paragraph (3)(A)(vi).'
